While at Booz, Warren led their FP&A, forecasting, and financial analytic and strategy teams after helping the company go public. Earlier in his career at Booz, Warren was the segment CFO for the \$1.5B Civilian Business / Commercial Business.

Warren also served at CGI Inc. (formerly AMS), Accenture (formerly Andersen Consulting LLP), in both segment CFO, segment Controller and finance leadership roles respectively.
